W. McAllister by then and there strangling the  
said George W. McAllister with a rope which  
said killing of him, the said George W. McAllister  
by them, the said John Doe whose true name

is unknown and Jack Robinson whose true  
name is unknown, was then and there without  
excuse, justification or authority of law.
